READ: Ro 5:6-11

Main Idea: The greatest act of love in history happened when Jesus died for us. People will sometimes give their life for someone who is a good person. But Jesus died for us while we were still sinful. He loved us when we were at our worst.

DISCUSS

Children: Our salvation is wonderful, sweet, and absolutely free! We know that we have received free grace from God instead of our deserved death. We know that Jesus paid the price for our eternal life. Thanking God for that gift reminds us that it's even better than candy! We are sometimes tempted to think that we can earn or pay for our own salvation by what we do or how we live. The beauty of grace is that it's free! Sin entered the world through Adam, but we can all have eternal life through Jesus! His death conquered sin and death, and we can live forever with Him because of His sacrifice.

Teen: Do you ever stop and really think about what Jesus did for you? Do you consider the pain He felt, or weight of all the sin he carried, or the separation from God that he endured? So, even at your worst, you were worth all this to Jesus. How does knowing this encourage you?

Adult: Powerless, ungodly, sinners & enemies. Can you think of any more hopeless description of us before Christ? Maybe Eph 2:12. Let's put ourselves in Jesus' shoes during his ministry. He knew every adult that he saw was in part the reason he would die on the cross. What emotions would that elicit in you? How could you continue in ministry knowing that? What focus would you have in order to continue? How was Jesus able to set all that aside and live a perfect life, to be the perfect sacrifice?
