## Week of Feb 16

### READ: Ro 3:1-8

**Main Idea:** In this passage Paul talks about a classic problem among God's people. We are proclaiming to a lost world the righteous and true way to live, given to us by our perfect God. However, we don't live perfectly. So do our mistakes and shortcomings mean our God is faithless too? Absolutely not!

### DISCUSS

**Children:** When we sin, we always receive consequences from that sin, even if we do not get caught or get in trouble because of it, we still have the feelings of guilt and shame that come from knowing we did it. Do you feel bad when you do wrong? Even if no one knows? Did Jesus ever do wrong? Remember the goal is to get other people to follow Jesus who is perfect, not us who are imperfect.

**Teen:** Our God is perfect, holy and righteous. Does our sin change that? What was God's plan to keep himself holy while making us clean? How do you explain to others just how faithful God is, in spite of the mistakes we make? What is the difference in living perfect, and living forgiven? Which are we able to do, and why?

**Adult:** Why do you think a faithful God allows us to sin and fall? He could have made us without free will but He didn't. Why didn't he enforce his will and make us be perfect? Conversely, why doesn't he display His wrath against mankind? Why do you think he allows the willful sin that we see today? Do you ever wonder how bad the earth was in Noah's time and if we are getting close?
