Week of Feb 23

READ: Ro 3:9-20

Main Idea: Even though the Jews had the Law of God about how to live righteous, that didn't give them an advantage regarding sin. They still sinned. They still were guilty because of their sin. Law doesn't remove sin, it makes us aware of more sin.

DISCUSS

Children: Jesus is teaching us that the things we say and the things we do come from what is inside of us... they do not come from what is outside of us. Think about the last time you were in trouble because you said or did something wrong. We all make mistakes, and no one is perfect. It's okay to mess up. God knows we aren't perfect, and He cares about us even when we fail. When you make mistakes should you be honest about it? Why? Will God help us start fresh?

Teen: Why do we need to know what sin is? What is the difference in recognizing sin, and removing sin? Why was the law able to make you aware of sin, but not forgive sin?

Adult: Once we sin, can we ever do enough to overcome that sin? The example of Hester Prynne from 2 weeks ago. Did her good works make her sinless or just more acceptable to the community? Does the world think that they can compensate for sin by doing some good deeds? Why do you think mankind believes that? Or do they believe it?
