



# Week of Feb 2

## READ: Ro 2:12-16

**Main Idea:** God is the ultimate judge. On the final day he will judge all mankind. The Israelites who lived under the Mosaic law will be judged by that law and those who did not live under that law will be judged by a law “written on their hearts.” In other words, we can fool others by our outward actions sometimes, and avoid consequences, but one day God will judge us all and there will be no fooling him.

## DISCUSS

**Children:** There’s a difference between people who go to church and pretend to be good, and someone who actually tries to do right. You need to read your bible, listen to the teachers and the preacher. Listen to your parents. God knows if you are pretending to try to learn about him and He knows if you are actually trying to do what He wants.

**Teen:** Can we fool others? Can we fool ourselves? Can we fool God? So, who needs to be the one we look to for answers and guidance in how we think, feel and act? What will help you set God as your compass and remind you to look to him for direction?

**Adult:** Have you known people who considered themselves “good” even though they freely admitted they had bad habits or did bad things? Did they consider themselves good because they didn't do anything really horrible? Why do you think we want to measure ourselves against other humans rather than against Jesus, the only perfect man, or against what God asks? Do you think even non-religious people know what is right and wrong?
