READ: Ro 1:16-17

Main Idea: The gospel is the good news that Jesus died and rose to free us from sin. This is wonderful news and Paul says he's not ashamed of it.

DISCUSS

Children: If Paul was not ashamed to preach the gospel, then we shouldn't be either! What is the gospel? What does it mean to share the gospel? How can you do this? Where can you do this? Draw a map from your house to the places you go (school, church, ballgames, friends, etc) and put an X on the places you shared with others about Jesus.

Teen: Why would Paul feel it necessary to say he is not ashamed by the gospel? How do the righteous live differently than people of the world? Can you be righteous without faith? Why or why not?

Adult: As a teen, were you ever embarrassed by your parents or by other family members? When you look back, do you realize that sometimes you were the shallow one, to be embarrassed by something trivial? We sometimes place reliance in something minor. Do you think it's because we're afraid of being judged because of someone else? Do you ever fear being judged for your faith in Christ? What are some reasons we should not be ashamed of the gospel, or of Christ?
