READ: Ro 2:6-11

Main Idea: God is patient about the time to send Jesus back to earth. During this time people are either storing up God's wrath because they are living selfish unrighteous lives, or they are storing up eternal treasure in heaven because they are living faithful God honoring lives. Its our choice.

DISCUSS

- Children:** 1. Every person will stand before God in judgment.
2. God will judge each person according to his _____. vs6
3. God is the judge who determines whether a person's deeds are good or evil.

Why do we need God and the Bible to tell us what is "good" or "bad?"

Teen: Paul is very clear with what action brings what consequence. How does a person behave if they are storing up God's wrath? What is the punishment? What is the behavior of one storing up treasure in heaven? What is the reward? Does your behavior reflect your choice to follow God?

Adult: When you hear that God will repay us according to what we've done, how does that make you feel? Do you feel like you have a set of scales and good deeds go on one side and evil deeds go on the other? Notice that this reading includes the idea of persistence or patience. Are you persistent in your deeds? Do you need to be more consistent in your actions? How can we encourage one another to do good deeds and to be persistent in them?
