READ: Ro 1:8-15

Main Idea: Paul is writing Christians in Rome and he starts by telling them how eager he is to come see them. In vs 11-12 he says he wants to come and impart a spiritual gift that will strengthen them. He goes on to say that they would be mutually encouraged by each other's faith. One of the wonderful parts of Christianity is how we can build each other up in our faith.

DISCUSS

Children: Paul tells the church he is writing to that their faith is being reported all over the world. If people were talking about your faith, how far would that news travel? He wants to see them so they could be mutually encouraged by each others faith. Do you ever feel like your faith is not as strong as it should be? If so, who do you ask for advice?

Teen: How do you encourage others with your faith? How are you encouraged by the faith of others? Is the Kingdom of God strengthened when Christians build each other up? Explain how.

Adult: Do you find that your faith weakens at times? Can you predict when you may struggle? Who do you turn to for encouragement in those times? What do you think it meant to the Roman Christians to hear that Paul would be encouraged by seeing their faith?
